EATING IN AND EATING OUT

Most Kosher consumers are very Makpid and careful that the Kosher standards in their home are of the very highest possible. Unfortunately, some find themselves inadvertently compromising these standards when eating out.

A non-Jewish executive from one of the largest supermarket chains in the world asked me to explain the following incident to him within the realm of Kashrus:

One of his Jewish managers proudly proclaimed to him one day that he “keeps strictly kosher”. The boss was therefore confused when he was invited to a BBQ, held at the manager’s home, hosted on his patio, where he saw shrimp cocktails, among other non-Kosher foods, being served. When he asked the manager about this contradiction he was told: “I keep strictly Kosher in my home, but that does not include the back porch or backyard”.

As amusing and distant as this seems for most of the Kosher-observant population, unfortunately, there are questionable situations that do occur even among knowledgeable and caring Shomer Kashrus families. The following are some concerns:

AT HOME

(our own and those we are invited to)

BISHUL AKUM Chazal forbade eating many types of food that were cooked by a non-Jew to prevent intermarriage and Kashrus concerns.. Ashkenazim can rely on the Ramah that states when a Jew lights a fire (for cooking purposes), or even a pilot light, it is sufficient to negate Bishul Akum (non-Jewish cooking). If a Jew over the age of 10 is keeping an eye on the Kashrus of the kitchen we can assume that the light did not go out and was not relit by a non-Jew. Experience has shown that if left alone, many housekeepers will relight or restart a range or oven as well as cook their own food in the Kosher oven and clean up well afterwards, not appreciating the damage done. After a utensil has been used by a Non-Jew without Jewish participation, the vessel needs Kashering. It is imperative to convey to any non-Jew in our home the vital importance of not using the kitchen in our absence. This needs to be ascertained by a Jew overseeing the kitchen or at least have live cameras active and a Jew occasionally entering the kitchen unannounced.

BOSOR SHNISALEM MIN HAAYIN

(food that has lost the integrity of its Kosher status)

Chazal forbade eating many types of food that were cooked by a non-Jew to prevent intermarriage and Kashrus concerns.. Ashkenazim can rely on the Ramah that states when a Jew lights a fire (for cooking purposes), or even a pilot light, it is sufficient to negate Bishul Akum (non-Jewish cooking). If a Jew over the age of 10 is keeping an eye on the Kashrus of the kitchen we can assume that the light did not go out and was not relit by a non-Jew. Experience has shown that if left alone, many housekeepers will relight or restart a range or oven as well as cook their own food in the Kosher oven and clean up well afterwards, not appreciating the damage done. After a utensil has been used by a Non-Jew without Jewish participation, the vessel needs Kashering. It is imperative to convey to any non-Jew in our home the vital importance of not using the kitchen in our absence. This needs to be ascertained by a Jew overseeing the kitchen or at least have live cameras active and a Jew occasionally entering the kitchen unannounced.

As long as we treat our Kosher food protection as well as we do our other valuables, such as jewelry, the Kosher status will remain even in our absence.

INSECT (TOLOYIM) CHECKING Due to insect consumption consisting of 6 Lavin (Avairos) in the Torah (Vayikra 11:41), this is always a very serious concern. Even triple-washed leafy produce often still contain an unacceptable level of infestation.

Non-Toveled utensils There are those who are meticulous concerning their Kashrus observance unfortunately neglect the Mitzvah and necessity of being Tovel their Kailim.

Sefer Bamidbar Pashas Matos Perek 31 Posuk 22 states

אך את הזהב ואת הכסף את הנחושת
את הברזל את הבדיל ואת העפרת

The next Posuk emphasizes

אך במי נדה יתחשא

These P'sukim are cited after the war with Midyan, that any utensils made of gold, silver, copper, iron, tin, lead and all types of metal, captured during the war, need to be Kashed first and then Toveled in a Mikvah before use (Gemorah Avodah Zara 75). Rashi understands this to be a general Mitzvah from the Torah, to be Tovel

utensils obtained from non-Jews. The Or Zarua also states that it is a Mitzva D'Oraisa, and Rav Shlomo Zalman Auerbach says that the Shagas Arye concurs with this opinion. The Ramban says that Tevilas Kailim in general is a Mitzvah from the Rabbonon, but not directly from the Torah. The Mishna B'Rura and Yechave Daas agree. Many Shuls have convenient special Mikvaos for Kailim (utensils) for public use.

STAM YAINAM If wine is not Mevushal (cooked) it too is considered a vehicle for intermarriage and is forbidden when touched by a non-Jew. Hence, Non-Mevushal wine left in a refrigerator needs to be well sealed, in a way that it clearly was not tampered with. According to Reb Moshe Feinstein wine is called Mevushal at a Pasteurization temperature of 175 degrees. According to Reb Elyoshiv and Reb Shlomo Zalman Auerbach the wine must be cooked at a much higher temperature to be called Mevushal. Most Kosher Grape Juice is Mevushal, with the exception of the 51 oz. glass bottles.

TERUMA/MAASER/SHMITTA ON PRODUCTS FROM ISRAEL

Due to the Kedusha of Eretz Yisroel, the produce requires additional procedures beyond produce from the rest of the world, such as bug infestation issues, before being ready to eat. The Torah instructs us to take of a certain amount of the produce for Kohanim, Leviim and the poor. The Rambam says that in our times this Mitzva is DeRabbonon. The Raavad disagrees and says that it is still a Mitzvah from the Torah. Therefore, one buying produce in Israel needs to be careful that it has a reliable Kosher certification that all Halachas of Kedushas Eretz Yisroel have been followed. When buying Israeli produce outside of Israel, all the above laws remain in effect. If purchased, one should consult a Rabbinic authority as to how to properly and halachically treat this produce. The Chief Rabbinate of Israel says that, unlike common misconceptions, they do not take Terumos and Maasros before exporting the produce. Since every seventh year in Israel has greater stringencies, the produce should not be purchased without a reliable Hechsher and if a person did obtain this produce they should ask a Rabbi how to conduct a proper disposal.

NON-RELIABLE KOSHER ITEMS With well over 1000 Kosher certifications worldwide, determining which have a reliable Kosher certification is a challenge that requires true dedication. There is a popular gelatin dessert in every market bearing a "K" which contains pork

gelatin. One should always consult their halachic authority to determine which Hechsherim meet their standards. A listing can be found at www.kosherquest.org.

KITCHEN MIX-UPS Entire sections of the Shulchan Aruch were written pertaining to kitchen mix-ups, such as Bosor B'Cholov, Taaruvos etc. It is beyond the scope of many people to apply all of these laws without having established a good connection to a Rabbi or organization who can deal knowledgeably with it.

OUT OF THE HOME

IS THE CATERER/RESTAURANT/ACQUAINTANCE WHERE WE ARE GOING TO DINE AT THE SAME LEVEL OF KASHRUS AS OUR OWN HOME?

Most Kosher certified restaurants today will use buzzwords such as Glatt/Mehadrin etc. However one needs to know if the owner/manager of the establishment is Shomer Shabbos and on site at all times, or, in lieu of that, is there a Mashgiach Temidi (constant supervision) who is truly there all hours that the establishment is open. Generally, a reliable Hashgacha will take care of this. When invited to someone's house we need to determine if the atmosphere is wholesome and is the food truly Kosher (encompassing all of the concerns we have stated above).

WERE THE KAILIM TOVELED? A Jewish caterer must be tovel all utensils that are used for his business. Often, caterers have a need to quickly purchase new items and do not have the availability to be tovel them. They often rely on what the Shulchan Aruch states: that if utensils are owned by a non-Jew, or even partially owned by a non-Jew, they do not require Tevila. Some caterers use a debatable method of forever "borrowing" the utensils from one of their workers.

IS INSECT CHECKING DONE AT YOUR DESIRED LEVEL? In Parshas Shmini (Vayikra 11:41) and Parshas Re'ea the Torah tells us over and over that we cannot eat insects. Often, when eating a salad, if a person, for instance, consumes even one insect, it constitutes 6 Avairos from the Torah. During the times when DDT was allowed and commonly used as a Pesticide, Reb Moshe said in Igros Moshe that insect consumption is not an issue in the U.S. However, now that the pesticides that are allowed to be used by farmers are much weaker, we find that insects have proliferated. Due to this severity and the difficulty of checking large amounts of produce, one must be

sure that a competent Yore Shomayim Mashgiach is on top of the checking. Needless to say, a vegetarian restaurant will need a very experienced Mashgiach, or will need to buy pre-checked and certified produce. Triple-washed produce is insufficient. Caterers and restaurants are under a great deal more pressure than a person at home, due to the volume and the immediate and constant need. Organic restaurants are an even greater concern as they generally buy produce that was not exposed to pesticide.

BISHUL AKUM All of the above concerns in a person's home are magnified in a restaurant/catering if the Mashgiach or Jewish owner leaves for a while and puts the non-Jews in charge.

IS THERE BOSOR SHNISALEM MIN HAAY-IN? AIRLINE MEALS/ RESTAURANT DELIVERIES Were the seals on the food intact when delivered? If not, see above. Numerous "Kashrus scandals" have occurred over the past few years by the lack of close, constant supervision over deliveries and shipments sent and received.

IS THE YOGURT STORE CERTIFIED BY A MASHGIACH OR BY NON-JEWS? Aid Echad Ne'Eman B'Issurim – One Shomer Shabbos Jew can attest to the Kosher status of a product. However, in most cases, a non-Jew does not share this capability. When a non-Kosher supervised yogurt store puts up signs claiming that they are using Kosher ingredients it is of course meaningless and usually not true. There are exceptions to this rule in other venues. These exceptions include unflavored water, pure fruits and vegetables, milk, franchise products and more. In those cases one can assume that what was claimed is accurate due to the compelling circumstances even when there is no local, onsite Mashgiach. Even in the above cases one should consult with their rabbi if and when they can use a product such as slurpees, fountain soda, coffee etc. without local Kosher supervision.

IS THE ATMOSPHERE KOSHER? I.E. CRUISE SHIPS, HOTEL, PARTY ETC. In Sefer Devorim Parshas Re'eh 14:8 the Torah singles out the pig as one of the animals that is not Kosher despite its "appearance" as Kosher, since it has split hooves. A common Yiddish idiom for a deceitful person is "Chazer Fissel", which means "pigs feet". The reasoning behind this is that at first glance the pig looks Kosher, as it seems to demonstrate by lying on its side, showing everyone its split hooves. However, upon closer inspection, one

sees what the Torah points out, that internally it does not chew its cud and therefore is not a Kosher animal. Chazal tell us to take the message from this that the Torah wants us to be Kosher externally as well as internally. This would preclude having a "food Kosher, but atmosphere traif" party/cruise/resort that is intrinsically not "Kosher" in other aspects.

ARE THEY CAREFUL NOT TO MIX MEAT WITH FISH? One of the more exciting culinary experiences at a Kosher resort/cruise is the Grand Kiddush, Midnight Shmorg etc. Extra care must be taken at these events to use separate plates for the fish and the meat. Mixing of the two is called by the Gemorah Pesachim (76B) Sakanta – dangerous to eat. The Shulchan Aruch in Yoreh Deah 116:2 says that for this reason, one must take a drink or eat something in between fish and meat. The Ramah forbids even cooking fish and meat in the same oven at the same time due to the vapors that would mix.

Montes brand Andinetas Mix (Chocolate Flavored Gems), sold at Sam's Club locations in

Mexico, have been mistakenly labeled with a plain O/K symbol. These products contain milk and are certified Kosher DAIRY.

BMA USA Oils and Vinegars are being sold bearing the Heart-K kosher symbol. BMA USA has not been certified by O/K Kosher since November 30, 2017.

A limited number of Snapple Diet Cranberry Raspberry 6 packs (16 oz. bottles) were mistakenly printed with the O/K Kosher symbol on the outer cartons. This product is NOT Kosher certified and the actual bottles do NOT bear the Kosher symbol.

Supremo Italiano Mozzarella, sold by Restaurant Depot, bears an unauthorized O/K symbol on the back label. This product is NOT certified by the O/K certification.

Moe's Ice Cream Truck, doing business in and around Deal, Long Branch and Neptune in New Jersey is displaying an unauthorized O/K Kosher symbol on the outside of the truck.

The Ktchn Restaurant, located in Los Angeles is no longer certified by O/K Kosher certification.

Princess Nut Vienesese Finger biscuits and Classic Tea Biscuits bear an unauthorized O/K Kosher symbol.

O/U:

The O/U certifies Splenda sweetener as an O/U pareve product. Some Splenda bags include sample Iced Tea Concentrate drink pods and Strawberry Watermelon Concentrate Drink Pods, which are certified by the O/U as O/Ud (dairy). The outer bags are labeled with both an O/U symbol and an O/Ud symbol. The O/U symbol pertains to the Splenda sweetener itself, while the O/Ud (dairy) symbol pertains to the drink pods.

The label on Borenstein's Vegetable Lasagna states "O/U Glatt Kosher and O/U Pareve". The ingredient panel correctly lists dairy Ingredients. Consumers should be alerted by any contradiction in the labeling and examine the contents of the meal before eating.

The O/U does not certify Le Tanou restaurant in France. They are displaying the O/U symbol

without authorization.

The O/U does not certify Kroger Sherry Cooking Vinegar. Some labels bear an unauthorized O/U symbol.

The O/U certifies Gefen Hungairan Sour Cherries as an O/UP product. Some cherries from a particular batch were found to have worms. This product is being withdrawn from the marketplace.

The O/U does not certify Harris Teeter Cranberry Black Cherry Juice Cocktail. Some labels bear an unauthorized O/U symbol.

The O/U certifies many varieties of Apple & Eve Juices. The certified products are labeled with an "O/U" symbol. Some of the 36 Count Variety packs do not bear an O/U symbol and states "made in Canada." The non-certified variety packs are sold in Costco and Sam's Club. Please always check for the O/U symbol before buying Apple & Eve Juices.

The O/U does NOT certify Korger brand Sherry Cooking Vinegar. Some labels bear an unauthorized O/U symbol.

The O/U does NOT certify Harris Teeter Cranberry Black Cherry Juice Cocktail. Some labels of this product bear an unauthorized O/U symbol.

The O/U will no longer certify Gerber Apple Banana with Oatmeal Cereal as a result of changes in production. The certified Apple Banana with Oatmeal Cereal has an O/U symbol and the non-certified product does NOT. Consumers should be careful to look for the O/U symbol prior to purchase.

The O/U does NOT certify California Classic Italian Style Dressing & Marinade. Some bottles were labeled with an unauthorized O/U symbol. This product contains a non-Kosher cheese and is being recalled.

FROM THE KVH:

Sabra Food Products (manufactured by International Food Products, Inc.) , including Hummus, BabaGhanoush, Tahini Sauce, Tabouli, Black Bean & Wheat Pilaf, Grape Leaves, Cracked Wheat Salad and Mediterranean Salad bear an unauthorized KVH Kosher Symbol.

Please Note: Sabra Food Products from Nor-

wood, Ma. is NOT affiliated with Sabra Dipping Co. in White Plains, N.Y., which remains under O/K/Rabbi Weissmandl certification for most of its hummus and guacamole products.

STAR K:

Rosh Hashanna Reminders:

Dates: It is recommended that one open and do a visual inspection on a few out of each container. If no insects can be seen, one can assume the rest are insect-free.

Figs: Open each one and check carefully for Infestation (typically wasps, beetles or worms).

Leeks: Examine the outside for any leaf minter trails. Check in between the leaves for thrips or other insects.

Black Eyed Peas: Dried peas should first be boiled in water. After they have been fully cooked, allow the peas to soak in the water for 2-3 hours. The peas will then swell and the peel will become translucent.

Canned or frozen peas may be checked straight out of the can/bag. There is no need to boil or soak.

To check, take the peas and inspect for holes or dark-colored stains as this may indicate an insect beneath the thin peel. If there is a dark spot on the peel, remove the thin skin and check if there is a cavity with a bug in it.

Baskin-Robbins new "non-dairy Chocolate Chip Cookie Dough Frozen" and "non-dairy Chocolate Extreme Frozen Dessert" bear a star-d symbol due to dairy equipment, and may be eaten after meat, but not with meat. In addition, the following Baskin-Robbins ices and sorbets bear a star-d due to dairy equipment and may be eaten after meat. Daiquiri Ice, Horchata Ice, Watermelon Splash Ice, Miami Vice Sorbet and Raspberry Sorbet ("sorbet" should not be confused with sherbet, which contains actual milk ingredients).

Cuisinart brand oven mitts, product of China, with label stating "100% Polyester Filling" contain a shatnez filling. They are not pure polyester as they contain wool and linen. In general, oven mitt fillings should be checked for shatnez, especially if they are made in China. Silicone mitts without a filling do not require checking.

Safir Canned Tomatoes with Tomato Juice & Basil, a product of Tunisia, bear an unauthorized Star-K sticker.

COR:

Sardo brand Antipasto Jalapenos Stuffed with Feta Cheese bears an unauthorized COR. This product is NOT KOSHER even when bearing a COR 77 symbol.

RCC:

As of Sunday, September 15, 2019, Santa Monica Glatt Market will no longer be under the Kashrus Certification of the RCC. No Kashrus violations were found.

CAPE TOWN BETH DIN:

Rice Krispy Toasted Rice Cereal Bar with melted marshmallow erroneously bears a Beth Din logo. This product is NOT Kosher.

Cape Dried Fruit Packers Wasabi peanuts is incorrectly labeled Pareve. The product is actually dairy.

Cape Dried Fruit Packers Bar Snack Mix is incorrectly labeled Pareve. The product is dairy.

These lots bear the EarthKosher symbol and are not certified. Lot# 190701 (8 oz.) and 190628 (1 lb.).
