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EATING IN AND EATING OUT

SHMITTA

Eretz Yisroel is blessed with many Mitzvos that the rest of the world lacks. This year, 5782, is the Shmitta year, the year in which the land is not worked, the farms are quiet, and the farmers are able to take a Sabbatical. It allows them to reconnect with their families and learn Torah without the pressure of daily farming. One year at the commencement of Shmitta, the Ponnev Rav, Harav Yosef Kahannaman ZTL, walked over to a tree, kissed it and wished it a Good Yom Tov. Although the Mitzvah is centered in Eretz Yisroel, it has many ramifications for those living in other countries as well. As the Posuk says¹ for six years we may tend to our fields but in the seventh year we must cease ערצת מינש שש. Although there are many laws associated with this great Mitzvah, which might confuse anyone not familiar with those laws, fortunately, one can mostly rely on their usual Hechsherim to take care of the Shmitta year issues. However, we are certainly still confronted with situations that require us to treat products from Israel with proper Halachic guidance for 7th year produce. If one were, for instance, to buy Jaffa Oranges, or wine from Israel produced this year, or lemon juice etc., the laws of Shmitta would be very relevant. If a product bears a reliable Hashgacha, it means that it was dealt with in a way that it was allowed to be sold. Produce grown this year normally is not allowed to be exported. However, produce grown in Israel this year on land fully owned by a non-Jew is fully permissible according to the Minhag of Yerushalayim,² while the Bnei Braq Minhag is not to use it. Certain areas of Israel, are not within the boundaries of Eretz Hakodesh and therefore, are not subject to the laws of Shviis. Although at one time, out of great necessity, the entire country was "sold" to a non-Jew in the manner of selling Chometz, most Poskim and Kashrus agencies agree that this "Heter Mechira" –is not normally effective or allowed. The majority of Poskim say that one is not allowed to sell Eretz Yisroel to a non-Jew, as it would lower its Kedusha. Fruit of Shviis must be treated with special regard as well, even out of the country. It normally cannot be thrown away or treated in a disrespectful manner. This necessitates throwing away left over fruit from Eretz Yisroel in a bag, leaving it to rot, and only then, discarding it in the trash. Certain fruits from the 7th year have restrictions next year after Rosh Hashana as well, due to their having been grown in the 7th year of Shmitta. This

Halacha is relevant to next year's crop of Esrogim as well. Most will sell a Lulav with Hadasim and Aravos and give a "free" Esrog with the set. In addition, for the next couple of years we will need to check Israeli wines that were produced during Shmita. Some will say "Heter Mechira" on them. The major Kashrus agencies of the world do not use this Heter. Otzar Beis Din, on the other hand, is a Heter that is widely used. This means that a Bais Din supervised sale, and the transport of produce took place with minimal payment to the orchard owner to cover expenses. These products, however, still need to be treated with proper handling of Kedushas Shviis produce (as mentioned above). Due to the complexity of the laws of Shmita, one should always check with their Rav when in doubt.

EATING AT HOME

Most Kosher consumers are very Makpid and careful that the Kosher standards in their home are of the very highest possible. Unfortunately, some find themselves inadvertently compromising these standards when eating out. The following are some of the concerns:

AT HOME

(our own and those we are invited to)

BISHUL AKUM

Chazal forbade eating many types of food that were cooked by a non-Jew, to prevent inter-marriage and Kashrus concerns. Ashkenazim can rely on the Ramah that states when a Jew lights a fire (for cooking purposes), or even a pilot light, it is sufficient to negate Bishul Akum (non-Jewish cooking). If a Jew over the age of 10 is keeping an eye on the Kashrus of the kitchen we can assume that the light did not go out and was not relit by a non-Jew. Experience has shown that if left alone, many housekeepers will relight or restart a range or oven as well as cook their own food in the Kosher oven and clean up well afterwards, not appreciating the Halachic damage done. After a utensil has been used by a Non-Jew, without Jewish participation, the vessel needs Kashering

BOSOR SHNISALEM MIN HAAYIN

(food that has lost the integrity of its Kosher status)

One of the most challenging situations in keeping a home kosher is that a Shomer Shabbos Jew has to be able to vouch for It's being Kosher at all times. The Halacha says that if one leaves a non - Jew alone in the home, in a situation where

non-kosher can happen, the house has to be treated as a non-kosher home until re-kashered. This means that if one leaves the home daily for a lengthy amount of time and a non-Jewish worker is aware that they are unsupervised during that time, the home can no longer be considered kosher. It is imperative to convey to any non-Jew in our home the vital importance of not using the kitchen in our absence. The kosher integrity of the kitchen needs to be ascertained by a Shomer Shabbos Jew, overseeing the kitchen. Yotze V'Nichnas (a Jew entering the house, unannounced occasionally) is acceptable. If this cannot be accomplished, minimally one should install a live active camera and inform the non-Jew that it is there. The housekeeper or worker needs to be aware that if they violate the Kashrus of the home it will be known and there will be consequences (Yotze V'Nichnas).

As long as we treat our Kosher food protection as well as we do our other valuables, such as jewelry, the Kosher status will remain intact, even in our absence.

INSECT (TOLOYIM) CHECKING

Due to insect consumption consisting of 6 Lavin (Avairos) in the Torah (Vayikra 11:41), this is always a very serious concern. Even triple-washed leafy produce often still contains an unacceptable level of infestation. Unless leafy produce is certified reliably to be insect free, one need to check carefully before serving.

NON TOVELED UTENSILS

There are those who are meticulous concerning their Kashrus observance unfortunately neglect or are unaware of the Mitzvah and necessity of being Tovel their Kailim.

Sefer Bamidbar Pashas Matos Perek 31 Posuk
22 states אך את הזהב ואת הכסף את הנחושת את
הברזל את הבדיל ואת העפרת

The next Posuk emphasizes אַךְ בְּמִי נִדְהָ יִתְחַטֵּא. These P'sukim are cited after the war with Midyan. They state that any utensils made of gold, silver, copper, iron, tin, lead and all types of metal, captured during the war, need to be Kasher'd first, and then Toveled in a Mikvah before use (Gemorah Avodah Zara 75). Rashi understands this to be a general Mitzvah from the Torah, to be Tovel utensils obtained from non-Jews. The Or Zarua also states that it is a Mitzva D'Oraisa, and Rav Shlomo Zalman Auerbach says that the Shagas Arye concurs with this opinion. The Ramban says that Tevilas Kailim in general is a Mitzvah from the Rabbonon, but not directly

from the Torah. The Mishna B'Rura and Yechave Daas agree. Many Shuls and even stores in certain frum cities, have convenient special Mikvaos for Kailim (utensils) for public use.

STAM YAINAM

If wine is not Mevushal (cooked) it too is considered a vehicle for intermarriage and is forbidden when touched by a non-Jew. Hence, Non-Mevushal wine left in a refrigerator needs to be well sealed, in a way that it clearly was not tampered with. According to Reb Moshe Feinstein wine is called Mevushal at a Pasteurization temperature of 175 degrees. According to Reb Elyoshiv and Reb Shlomo Zalman Auerbach the wine must be cooked at a much higher temperature to be called Mevushal. Most Kosher Grape Juice is Mevushal, with the exception of the 51 oz. glass bottles.

TERUMA/MAASER/SHMITTA ON PRODUCTS FROM ISRAEL

Due to the Kedusha of Eretz Yisroel, the produce requires additional procedures beyond produce from the rest of the world, such as bug infestation issues, before being ready to eat. The Torah instructs us to take of a certain amount of the produce for Kohanim, Leviim and the poor. The Rambam says that in our times this Mitzva is DeRabbonon. The Raavad disagrees and says that it is still a Mitzvah from the Torah. Therefore, one buying produce in Israel needs to be careful that it has a reliable Kosher certification that all Halachas of Kedushas Eretz Yisroel have been followed. When buying Israeli produce outside of Israel, all the above laws remain in effect. If purchased, one should consult a Rabbinic authority as to how to properly and halachically treat this produce. The Chief Rabbinate of Israel says that, unlike common misconceptions, they do not take Terumos and Maasros before exporting the produce. Since every seventh year in Israel has greater stringencies, the produce should not be purchased without a reliable Hechsher and if a person did obtain this produce they should ask a Rabbi how to conduct a proper disposal. Some supermarkets sell fresh produce with a large certification on each piece. This is very helpful in particular with produce from Israel. A good Hashgacha covers all of the above concerns.

NON-RELIABLE KOSHER ITEMS

With well over 1000 Kosher certifications worldwide, determining which have a reliable Kosher certification is a challenge that requires true dedication. There is a popular gelatin dessert in

every market bearing a "K" which contains pork gelatin. One should always consult their halachic authority to determine which Hechsherim meet their standards. A listing can be found at www.kosherquest.org.

KITCHEN MIX-UPS

Entire sections of the Shulchan Aruch were written pertaining to kitchen mix-ups, such as Bosor B'Cholov, Taaruvos etc. It is beyond the scope of many people to apply all of these laws without having established a good connection to a Rabbi or organization who can deal knowledgeably with it.

EATING OUT OF THE HOME

CATERERS AND RESTAURANTS

Is the caterer/restaurant/acquaintance where we are going to dine at the same level of kashrus as our own home?

Most Kosher certified restaurants today will use buzzwords such as Glatt/Mehadrin etc. However, one needs to know if the owner/manager of the establishment is Shomer Shabbos and on site at all times, or in lieu of that, is there a Mashgiach Temidi (constant supervision) who is truly there all hours that the establishment is open. Generally, a reliable Hashgacha will take care of this. When invited to someone's home for a meal, we need to determine if the atmosphere is wholesome and if the food truly Kosher (encompassing all of the concerns we have stated above).

Were the kailim toveled?

A Jewish caterer must be tovel all utensils that are used for his business. Often, caterers have a need to quickly purchase new items and do not have the availability to be tovel them. They often rely on what the Shulchan Aruch states: that if utensils are owned by a non-Jew, or even partially owned by a non-Jew, they do not require Tevila. Some caterers use a debatable method of forever "borrowing" the utensils from one of their workers.

Is insect checking done at your desired level?

In Parshas Shmini (Vayikra 11:41) and Parshas Re'ea the Torah tells us over and over that we cannot eat insects. Often, when eating a salad, if a person, for instance, consumes even one insect, it constitutes 6 Avairos from the Torah. During the times when DDT was allowed and commonly used as a Pesticide Reb Moshe said in Igros Moshe that insect infestation is not an issue in the U.S. However, now that the pesticides that are allowed to be used by farmers are much

weaker, we find that insects have proliferated. Due to this severity and the difficulty of checking large amounts of produce, one must be sure that a competent Yore Shomayim Mashgiach is on top of the checking. Many of the reliable Hashgachos will certify produce that still needs to be checked. The Star K, Badatz and a few others will only certify produce that is completely ready to eat without further checking. In general, bug free produce will proudly say so on the package. Needless to say, a vegetarian restaurant will need a very experienced Mashgiach, or will need to buy pre-checked and certified produce. Triple-washed produce is insufficient. Caterers and restaurants are under a great deal more pressure than a person at home, due to the volume and the immediate and constant need. Organic restaurants are an even greater concern as they generally buy produce that was not exposed to pesticide and may have a higher infestation rate.

Bishul Akum

All of the above concerns in a person's home are magnified in a restaurant/catering if the Mashgiach or Jewish owner leaves for a while and puts the non-Jews in charge. In general airline meals must be checked for certification as they often change depending on the country and direction they are flying out of.

Is there bosor shnisalem min haayin? Airline meals/restaurant deliveries

Were the seals on the food intact when delivered? if not, see above. Numerous "Kashrus scandals" have occurred over the past few years by the lack of close, constant supervision over deliveries and shipments sent and received.

Is the yogurt store certified by a mashgiach or by non-Jews?

Aid Echad Ne'Eman B'Issurim – One Shomer Shabbos Jew can attest to the Kosher status of a product. However, in most cases, a non-Jew does not share this capability. When a non Kosher-supervised yogurt store puts up signs claiming that they are using Kosher ingredients it is of

course meaningless and usually not true. There are exceptions to this rule in other venues. These exceptions include unflavored water, pure fruits and vegetables, milk, franchise products and more. In those cases, one can assume that what was claimed is accurate due to the compelling circumstances even when there is no local, onsite Mashgiach. Even in the above cases one should consult with their rabbi when they can use a product such as slurpees, fountain soda, coffee etc. without local Kosher supervision.

Is the atmosphere kosher? i.e. cruise ships, hotel, party etc.

In Sefer Devorim Parshas Re'eh 14:8 the Torah singles out the pig as one of the animals that is not Kosher despite its "appearance" as Kosher, since it has split hooves. A common Yiddish idiom for a deceitful person is "Chazer Fissel", which means "pigs feet". The reasoning behind this is that at first glance the pig looks Kosher, as it seems to demonstrate by lying on its side, showing everyone its split hooves. However, upon closer inspection, one sees what the Torah points out, that internally it does not chew its cud and therefore is not a Kosher animal. Chazal tell us to take the message from this that the Torah wants us to be Kosher externally as well as internally. This would preclude having a "food Kosher, but atmosphere traif" party/cruise/resort that is intrinsically not "Kosher" in other aspects.

Are they careful not to mix meat with fish?

One of the more exciting culinary experiences at a Kosher resort/cruise is the Grand Kiddush, Midnight Shmorg etc. Extra care must be taken at these events to use separate plates for the fish and the meat. Mixing of the two is called by the Gemorah Pesachim (76B) Sakanta – dangerous to eat. The Shulchan Aruch in Yoreh Deah 116:2 says that for this reason, one must take a drink or eat something in between fish and meat. The Ramah forbids even cooking fish and meat in the same oven at the same time due to the vapors that would mix.

Country Crock: The O/U certifies many, but NOT ALL Country Crock products. Country Crock products with the O/U symbol are certified Kosher while the Country Crock products without the O/U symbol are not.

Tapatio Ramen Noodle Soup Shrimp Flavor: Tapatio Shrimp flavored Ramen Soups come in different sized containers. The 3.7 ounce bowls are NOT certified by the O/U and do NOT bear an O/U symbol. The 2.29 ounce cups were certified by the O/U and bear an O/U symbol. The O/U will no longer appear on the label. It is possible that both the certified and non-certified products will be sold simultaneously as the supply of the O/U certified product is being depleted. Consumers should be careful to look for the O/U symbol before purchasing products.

Season Sardines: As previously posted, due to Covid 19 work and travel restrictions, some Season Sardines, Sprats and Kipper Snacks products were produced as non-Kosher and do NOT bear an O/U symbol. Unfortunately, their packaging is identical to O/U certified products, except for the absence of the O/U, and this has led to numerous mix-ups for the Kosher consumer, even in Kosher stores. Be careful to check every can for the O/U symbol.

Lay's Wavy Potato Chips: Lay's Wavy Original Potato Chips bearing an O/U, mistakenly contains Sour Cream & Onion Potato Chips (NOT O/U certified and also dairy) in a small number of 7 3/4 oz. bags.

Golden Natural Products Dried Cherry Plums: The O/U does NOT certify Golden Natural Products Dried Cherry Plums. Some packaging bears an unauthorized O/U symbol.

Heart Of Jerusalem Restaurants: The O/U does NOT certify Heart of Jerusalem Restaurants.

Keto Shortbread Cooked Mix: The O/U certifies Keto and Co. Shortbread Cookie Mix as an O/UD (dairy) product. Some packages of this product were labeled with a plain "O/U", without the "D" (dairy) designation. This product contains dairy as indicated in the ingredients statement.

Price Chopper PICS Ham: The O/U does NOT certify PICS Ham. Some packages of this product bear an unauthorized O/U.

Botticelli Balsamic Vinegar: The O/U does NOT certify Botticelli Balsamic Vinegar. Some bottles bear an unauthorized O/U symbol.

Chef's Warehouse Chocoo Crisp Strawberry Chocolate Décor Pearls: The O/U does NOT certify Chocoo Crisp Strawberry Chocolate Pearls. Some containers were labeled with an unauthorized O/U symbol.

KLBD:

McCain: McCain products are no longer approved by the KLBD. Existing stock sold in Kosher shops that are bearing a KLBD and MKL sticker are still KLBD/MKL certified. Some of these products are certified by SKA when bearing their logo on the packaging.

STAR K:

Kitchen Aid French Door Refrigerators: It has come to the attention of the Star-K that in certain models of their Sabbath Mode Certified Kitchen Aid Air French Door Refrigerators - among them KRFC302ESS and KRSC503ESS - the interior lights continue to be operational even in Sabbath mode. To determine if your model has this issue, do the following...

A.) Set the Sabbath Mode

B.) Keeping the left door and freezer drawer closed, open the right door. If there is no light displaying, your unit is fine and operational. If you see a light, however dim, you will need to tape down both refrigerator switches and the freezer switch before Shabbos and Yom Tov. Be sure to remove the tape after Shabbos/Yom Tov. Clover Valley Coffee Creamer at Dollar General Stores: Clover Valley Coffee Creamer, sold at Dollar General Stores, bears an unauthorized Star-K symbol on some containers and is NOT certified by the Star-K.

Natural Earth Yaki Sushi Nori: Please be advised that .70 oz. packages of Natural Earth Toasted Yaki Sushi Nori that bear an expiration code of Feb. 11 2022, were labeled incorrectly. This lot was NOT checked and is NOT certified Kosher. Consumers who purchased this product bearing this date, must check it prior to use. Other lots of Natural Earth Nori are certified when bearing the Star-K symbol.

KOF K:

Ben & Jerry's:

Although Ben & Jerry's and its parent company, Unilever, announced that they will not be leaving Israel, the Kof-K is quite concerned about Ben & Jerry's decision not to sell to Yehuda and Shomron as of January 1, 2023. Unilever has committed that the company will adhere to their contract. The Kof-K has been in contact with the Israeli government and the Yesha Council to determine the most effective way to respond. Based on the advice of the Yesha council, the Kof-K will continue to fulfill its contractual obligations to Ben & Jerry's while using its influence to make sure that this anti-Israel policy never becomes implemented. The Kof-K has expressed to Unilever and Ben & Jerry's CEOs the negative repercussions of this policy.

The Kof-K encourages everyone to advocate on behalf of Israel. Please address your concerns about this policy directly to Unilever and Ben & Jerry's. This is a highly volatile situation and the Kof-K remains in contact with the Israeli government and the Yesha Council as the most prudent way to make sure the policy never becomes implemented.

Hain Celestial Terra Chips: effectively immediately - due to various considerations, Hain Celestial

terra chips (all flavors) is no longer certified as bishul yisroel. Products which either have the bishul yisroel declaration or are marked with a julian date of 2/05/21 or earlier, may still be considered bishul yisroel.

Keranique brand kera viatin health supplements: kof-k kosher supervision announces that keranique brand kera viatin hair and scalp health supplements have been mistakenly labeled with an unauthorized kof-k on their packaging. This company is not certified by the kof-k.

Maple Ridge Farms Coconut Praline Pecans: Please be advised that Coconut Praline Pecans, 5 oz. box, distributed by Maple Ridge Farms Inc., is certified as cRc - dairy. Some boxes contain an ingredient card inside the box that erroneously has a cRc pareve logo. This product is DAIRY (Cholov Stam).

Mission Foods Tortillas: Mission Foods Tortillas and related products are certified by the cRc only when produced in the U.S. Mission Foods has recently started Importing similar non-certified products that are produced In Mexico, which state "made in Mexico" on the label and do NOT bear a cRc. Be careful to check each bag for the cRc logo. This product is NOT Pas Yisroel.

Royal Bee Icing Décoration (Leonardo Sweets): Please be aware that Royal Bee Icing Décoration, under the brand name Leonardo Sweets (Ohr Yehudah, Israel) Is being sold in Israel with an unauthorized cRc logo. This product, which is manufactured in China, Is NOT Kosher certified by the cRc.

Golden Ticket Psilocybin Mushroom Chocolate Bar: Please be aware that www.buypsychedelicsonline.com is selling a Golden Ticket - Psilocybin Mushroom Chocolate Bar (3.5 g) with an unauthorized cRc pareve logo. The cRc does NOT certify this product as Kosher.

Chocolate Works S'Mores: Chocolate Works S'Mores, manufactured by 5th Avenue Chocolatiere in Freeport, N.Y. is cewrtified as dairy by the cRc. Current packages of the product are missing the "dairy" designation.
